ISA Delhi AGBM 2025 Minutes of Meeting

AGBM 2025 (meeting of the Governing Council, Executive Committee and members of the Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists, Delhi Branch) was held during ISACON Delhi 2025.

Date & Time: 14th September 2025, 2:30pm

Venue: ISACON Delhi 2025 Conference venue i.e. Central Ball Room, Hotel Hyatt Centric, Janakpuri, New Delhi

As the meeting quorum was not complete so meeting was adjourned for 15 minutes and all members were recollected in same venue.

Minutes: (Jotted down by Dr Nitesh Goel, GC member)

1. Welcome address by President Dr. Munisha Agarwal. She briefed about "Green OT concept" and thanked all members for full support throughout her tenure. She appreciated the work done by Honorary secretary ISA Delhi, ably supported by Honorary Treasurer & all other governing council members throughout the year.
2. Two condolences were announyed (Dr Pushpa Saxena and Dr Kirti N Saxena); One minute silence was observed.
3. Attendance was as per GBM register.
4. MOM of last AGBM 2024 were presented by Honorary Secretary Dr. Amit Kohli. It was proposed by Dr. Akhilesh Gupta & seconded by Dr. Nishkarsh Gupta.
5. MOM of special GBM 2024 were presented in which Tresurers report 2024 was passed and all members were informed about continuation of tenure of Treasurer Dr Abhijit Kumar and GC member Ridhima Sharma. Also decision to co-opt Dr Nishkarsh as editor was announced. It was proposed by Dr Ranajit Chaterjee and seconded by Dr Arvind Arya .

6. Secretary's report was presented by Dr. Amit Kohli (Honorary Secretary ISA Delhi). He informed the house about all new initiatives by Delhi Branch in 2024-2025 and also praised the entire governing council for their constant support and diligent efforts. The report was passed after being proposed by Dr. Baljit Singh and seconded by Dr. Akhilesh Gupta.

7. Treasurer's report was presented by Dr. Abhijit Kumar (Honorary Treasurer ISA Delhi). Audited report of ISACON Delhi 2024 was also read. He informed that audit of YUVACON 2025 is undergoing. He also informed about we have income over expenditure of around 10 laks in year 2024-2025. It was much applauded by GBM members . It was proposed by Dr Akhilesh Gupta and seconded by Dr Rajiv Gupta.

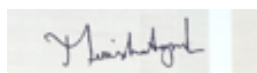
8. Editor's report was presented by Dr. Nishkarsh Gupta (Editor ISA Delhi). He informed the house about nine issues released last year and thanked all authors and readers. It was proposed by Dr. Akhilesh Gupta and seconded by Dr. Nishant Kumar.

9. Maintenance of the flat: Actions taken and way forward - Dr. Amit Kohli informed the AGBM that flat in the possession of ISA Delhi at Gautam nagar has no electricity, water and has massive sewerage and seepage issue. Honorary Secretary is getting repeated threats from neighbours to get their affected permises repaired which causes inconvenience. A decision was taken in AGBM 2024 that this flat is a liability for ISA Delhi and is on lal dora land so process should be initaited to sell this flat at early as possible. In this regard two online meetings of the core committee which was made in AGBM 2023 (chaired by Dr Baljit Singh) were held in February and July 2025. Dr Ranajit Chaterjee member of the core committee had shown available papers to municipal authroties and lawyers and found that they are sufficient to sell the flat. Honorary Secretary informed that anonymous inquiry was conducted with neighbourhood property dealers and valuation of around 65-70 Lakhs was made as there are lots of house tax, electricity and jal board penalty to be settled. AGBM decided that in best interest of its members valuation of this flat should be re-sought and AGBM decided to sell this flat whenever appropriate valuation was made. It was proposed by Dr Nishkarsh Gupta and seconded by Dr Arvind Arya.

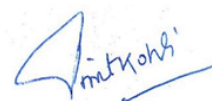
10. ISA Delhi election nominations revision as per ISA National guidelines: Dr Amit Kohli proposed that governing council ISA Delhi is of strong opinion that ISA Delhi elections should be conducted with same rules and term periods of ISA National. He proposes that members applying for the post of President, Vice President, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Treasurer should have served a complete term of 3 years as GC member. He also informed that all states are receiving repeated communication from national body to reform our election rules. Senior members Dr Baljit Singh, Dr Anshu Gupta, Dr Rajiv Gupta all were of opinion that Delhi is not in a position to adopt election rules on the lines of ISA national fully as posts of GC members have been inducted just 5 years ago. They also emphasised Delhi follows its own constitution which has separate election regulations. However they also opined that in due course of time we need to follow election regulation of national body after passing it in subsequent GBMs.

11. Dr. Amit Kohli announced ISA Delhi elections 2025 results and congratulated the elected candidates: President Dr. Neerja Banerjee, Vice President Dr. Gurpreet Singh Popli and Editor Dr Farah Husain. The charge assumption shall be during WAD celebrations on 16th October 2025.

Honorary secretary ISA Delhi thanked all the members present in the AGBM 2025. Meeting ended with presidential vote of thanks by Dr Munisha Agarwal.
